041-21. Sgt. Daniel Boudreau, to install stop sign on East side of Stoneybrook Road at the intersection with Village Crossing, where the divided entrance to Stoneybrook meets Village Crossing.

The Public Safety Committee recommended by unanimous consent that the Petition be held as Sgt. Boudreau was not available for comment.

042-21. Councillor Marisa Fleming, to review the no parking restrictions on Eastlin Way to determine whether or not the restrictions should be expanded to include no parking on both sides of a portion of Eastlin Way.

The Public Safety Committee recommended by unanimous consent that the Petition be held as Councillor Fleming was not available for comment.

045-21. Desilets Auto, Inc., to petition for a Class II Dealer’s License located at 236 Lunenburg Street, Fitchburg, MA.
