The City of Fitchburg, Department of Public Works, advises residents of the following work that will be done – weather permitting – during the week of November 18.

Water Meter Upgrade Project in all wards' Monday – Saturday, 8 AM to 4 PM: Baystate Winsupply is the only Contractor for this ongoing project. Baystate Winsupply will be replacing and installing new water meters inside buildings and homes throughout the City. Customers are notified via U.S. postal mail. Once a customer is notified by Baystate Winsupply, there will be instructions to make appointments for meter replacement through a website or over the phone.

Road Work; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Minor traffic impacts:

- Repair potholes throughout city
Use SeeClickFix.com or call 978-829-1900 to report a pothole
- Catch basin cleaning in Ward 5
- Swale cleaning on Townsend St
- Sidewalk installation on Franklin Rd and Oak Hill Rd
- Catch basin repair on Leighton St
- Continue working on water service lines at multiple locations on Summer St, between Main St and Harvard St as weather allows
- Replace City side of water service at 58 Holt St
- Complete trench restoration/paving on Summer St at locations where water service lines were replaced.
- Manhole installations on Normandy & Leyton Streets M-F 7 AM to 4 PM. Expect local road closures.
- Sewer cleaning City wide. Expect local lane shifts or detours.

- Gas main work by Unitil; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 4 PM; Expect delays and detours in the areas of:
 - Portland St
 - Crown St
 - Washington St
 - Everett St
 - South St

Hydrants:

- Winterizing hydrants on the High System (hydrants with red bonnets/tops) throughout the City.
