III. SUMMONS HEARING

British American Club, 1 Simonds Rd. for Failed/Noncompliant inspection of premises

Beemer's Pub, 310 Main St. – Peter Cote, Manager and Tryst Lounge, 320 Main St. – Vilma Darcangelo, Manager

Allegation as reported by FPD Lt. Howe:

On 7/13/19 at 3:45PM Beemers Pub had an event. During the event multiple people were outside in the street and parking lot drinking alcohol. Pete Cote, owner of Beemer's was in attendance. The owner of Tryst wants to lodge a complaint against Beemer's Pub and owner Peter Cote. Heather Silvera (owner of Tryst) wishes to testify before the Board for what she witnessed. She stated people were leaving Beemers with alcoholic drinks and walked across the street and they attempted to get in to Tryst with alcohol which they took from Beemers. She said multiple did this.

IV. CONTINUED SUMMONS HEARING

Beemer's Pub, 310 Main St. – Peter Cote, Manager
Allegation:

Disturbance on Premise; Riot; Failure to disperse on April 20, 2019 at approximately 0139 hours. Two separate fights. An Officer on patrol observed a fight at Beemers near the rear door. The fight involved two girls pushing each other with 20-30 people involved in trying to break up the fight. While that fight was ending another fight flared up involving an additional 8-12 males and it spilled out on to Boulder Drive. Beemer's security reported to the police officer that the incident was a carry-over from something that took place earlier in the night.
