FITCHBURG – The Department of Public Works advises residents of the following work that will be done, weather permitting, during the week of May 2, 2022.

**Road Construction**

Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Expect road closures, delays and detours.

- P.J. Albert Inc. will be continuing work on the Main Street and Boulder Drive 2-Way conversion. Traffic signal, road way lighting poles, and mast arms assembly and installation to commence along Boulder Drive and Main Street. Expect temporary road closures and delays throughout the week. Please note business along main Street and Boulder Drive are open during construction. Parking is available at the Mill Street and Putnam Street parking garages.
  - Tentatively scheduled: Main Street to become single lane travel. West bound only at the approach to the common/lower area on Tuesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>. This traffic pattern to remain permanently.
- Util will be conducting natural gas pipeline replacement projects starting the week of May 2<sup>nd</sup> in the area of Wanoosnoc Road, Greenhurst Ave, Rodiman Ave, Mechanic Street, Whittemore Street, Buttrick Ave., and Stockwell Ave. The contractors Neuco, S. Fors, Feeney Brothers and O.G. Croteua, plan to work 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Expect temporary road closures and delays. Residents will be given notice on any planned service interruptions associated with the gas work. The work is scheduled to be completed this summer. Please note that all businesses on Mechanic Street will remain open during construction.

Combination Sanitary Sewer/Storm Drain Separation Project. Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Expect detours, lane shifts, road closures, and traffic delays.

- On-going Combination Sanitary Sewer/Storm Drain Separation Project:
  - Payson Street from Walnut Street to House #113 – Scheduled Sewer and Drain Replacement.
    - Expect detours, lane shifts, road closures, and traffic delays.
- Cured in Place Pipe Lining to be installed in select Sewer Manholes on Delisle Street, Water Street, Legros Street, Main Street and Laurel Street.
  - Expect detours, lane shifts, road closures, and traffic delays.

Monday –Friday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards.
- Repair water gate boxes at various locations throughout the City.
- Catch basin repair will be performed on Princeton Road.
- Sidewalk repairs will be performed on Day Street.

#### **Hydrants**

- Hydrant maintenance City-wide.
- Hydrant flushing in the Princeton Road, Authority Drive, Fifth Mass Turnpike, and Westminster Street areas.
