FITCHBURG – The Department of Public Works advises residents of the following work that will be done, weather permitting, during the week of April 25, 2022.

**Road Construction**

Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Expect road closures, delays and detours.

- P.J. Albert Inc. will be continuing work on the Main Street and Boulder Drive 2-Way conversion. Electrical conduit work with existing street light and light pole removal followed by installation of new street lights, light poles and light concrete bases will be performed on Putnam Street, Boulder Drive, Main Street, and in the area around City Hall. Reconstruction of existing traffic pattern at Boulder Drive and Main Street across from the common. Expect temporary road closures and delays throughout the week. Please note businesses along Main Street and Boulder Drive are open during construction. Parking is available at the Mill Street and Putnam Street parking garages.
- Util will be conducting natural gas pipeline replacement projects starting the week of April 25<sup>th</sup> in the area of Wanoosnoc Road, Greenhurst Ave, Rodiman Ave, Mechanic Street and Whittemore Street. The contractors Neuco, S. Fors, Feeney Brothers and O.G. Croteau, plan to work 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Residents will be given notice on any planned service interruptions associated with the gas work. The work is scheduled to be completed this summer.

Combination Sanitary Sewer/Storm Drain Separation Project. Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Expect detours, lane shifts, road closures, and traffic delays.

- On-going Combination Sanitary Sewer/Storm Drain Separation Project:
  - Walnut Street from Water Street to Payson Street – Scheduled Sewer Replacement Construction will continue
  - Payson Street from Walnut Street to House #113 – Scheduled Sewer and Drain Replacement.
    - Expect detours, lane shifts, road closures, and traffic delays.
- Cured in Place Pipe Lining to be installed in select Sewer Manhole on Worcester Street, Washington Street, Chester Street, and Portland Street.
  - Expect detours, lane shifts, road closures, and traffic delays.

Monday –Friday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards.
- Repair water gate boxes at various locations throughout the City.
- Catch basin repair will be performed on Kimball Street.
- Sidewalk repairs will be performed on Day Street.

#### **Hydrants**

- Hydrant maintenance City-wide.
- Hydrant flushing in the Shea Street and Rollstone Road areas.

#### **Street Sweeping 2022**

- Street sweeping of Ward 5 will continue during the day beginning on Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Residents are asked to sweep sidewalks in front of their homes. Sand should be placed in wind rows – not in piles – so that the equipment can successfully remove it.**
