FITCHBURG – The Department of Public Works advises residents of the following work that will be done, weather permitting, during the week of April 24, 2023.

Road Construction

Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Expect road closures, delays and detours.

- Due to building construction at the Dickenson Building located at 37 Boulder Drive, Cushing Street is closed to pedestrian traffic.
- MassDOT will be continuing their reconstruction and rehabilitation of the Circle Street Bridge. Due to construction, the bridge will remain closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic until further notice.

Combination Sanitary Sewer/Storm Drain Separation Project. Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Expect detours, lane shifts, road closures, and traffic delays.

- On-going Combination Sanitary Sewer/Storm Drain Separation Project:
 - No construction work will be conducted this week.

Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards.
- Picking up of City trees.
- Repair water gate boxes at various locations throughout the City.
- Util will be conducting natural gas pipeline replacement projects in the areas of Franklin Road, Electric Ave, Simonds Street, Nutting Street, Rodiman Ave, Dailey Terrace, Elm Street from Oliver Street to Hartwell Street, Apple Tree Hill, Forest Park and Paulson Terrace. The contractors Neuco, S. Fors, Feeney Brothers and O.G. Croteau, plan to work 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Expect detours, temporary road closures and delays. Residents will be given notice on any planned service interruptions associated with the gas work.
- Pine Ridge Technologies (PRT) will finish installing streetlight bases and begin installing replacement aluminum light poles on various streets throughout the City.
- Taylor Davis Landscaping will be completing granite curbing adjustments and pouring concrete sidewalks at Moran Square to complete the project for 10 Main Street.

Hydrants

- Hydrant maintenance City-wide.
- Tuesday through Friday – Hydrant flushing on the Low Water System (hydrants with black tops) in the Main Street, Lunenburg Street, and Summer Street areas.

Street Sweeping 2023

- Street sweeping of Wards 1, 2 & 3 are complete.
- Street sweeping of Ward 4 to be completed:
 - 4B will be performed at night and 4A will be performed during the day.
- Street sweeping of Ward 5 estimated to begin on May 1st
 - 5A will be performed at night and 5B will be performed during the day.

Residents are asked to sweep sidewalks in front of their homes. Sand should be placed in wind rows – not in piles – so that the equipment can successfully remove it.
