The City of Fitchburg, Department of Public Works, advises residents of the following work that will be done – weather permitting – during the week of April 20, 2020.

The Water Meter Upgrade Project is currently on hold until further notice due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Street Sweeping; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM:

- Daytime spot sweeping in ward 5. Please place sand for sweeper in windrows, not piles

Road Work; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards
Use SeeClickFix.com or call 978-829-1900 to report a pothole.
- Sewer manhole replacements on Water St between Newton St & Krysiak St. Expect local road closures Monday thru Thursday.
- Pulverizing of Lenox, Garfield, Richmond, Berkley Streets will begin on Tuesday.
- Gas main work by Utilil/NEUCO on Water St at Walnut St. Expect delays.
- Utilil will have tree crews on Ashburnham Hill Rd and mowing crews off Rollstone Rd & South St.
- On Thursday 4/23 Utilil will have a tree crew working at Crocker School for a planned outage.
- MassDOT's contractor will be performing nighttime roadwork on the Rte 31 bridge over Phillips Brook. Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday at 9 PM and be completed by Wednesday 3:30 PM. One lane of traffic will be allowed to pass. Police details will be directing traffic.

Hydrants:

- Inspection, maintenance and painting of hydrants City wide.
- Spring hydrant flushing will be delayed until further notice as to not cause discolored water for residents.
