The City of Fitchburg, Department of Public Works, advises residents of the following work that will be done – weather permitting – during the week of June 1, 2020.

The Water Meter Upgrade Project is currently on hold until further notice due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Street Sweeping:

- Monday - Friday 7 AM – 3 PM spot sweeping City Wide.
- Residents are asked to sweep sidewalks in front of their properties.
- Sand should be placed in wind rows and not in piles so that the equipment can successfully remove it.

Road Work; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards
Use SeeClickFix.com or call 978-829-1900 to report a pothole.
- Sidewalk construction on Franklin Rd and Reingold Ave.
- Crosswalk painting on River St and Westminster St.
- Loam and seed in the areas of Lenox, Garfield, Richmond, Berkley Streets.
- Catch basin repair on Fairmount St and Plymouth St; also at 230 Walton St.
- Sewer cleaning & TV of various locations Monday – Friday 7 AM to 3 PM. Expect localized detours and lane shifts.
- Restoration/paving of trenches on Wallace Rd by house #95 and Amount Terrace Tuesday; in the area of 362 Wanoosnoc Rd on Thursday.
- Sidewalk restoration in the areas of 391 Clarendon St and the area of 203 Madison St.
- Gas main work by Utilil/NEUCO on First St, Beech St, York Ave and Hannigan Court. Expect road closures, detours and delays.
- Utilil will have tree crews working on High St.
- Any Utilil customer can claim 2 free trees for their property by visiting Arborday.org/Utilil.

Hydrants:

- Inspection, maintenance and painting of hydrants City wide.
- Spring hydrant flushing will be delayed until further notice as to not cause discolored water for residents.
