The City of Fitchburg, Department of Public Works, advises residents of the following work that will be done – weather permitting – during the week of May 11, 2020.

The Water Meter Upgrade Project is currently on hold until further notice due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Street Sweeping:

- Monday - Friday 7 AM – 3 PM sweeping of ward 2A and 3B.
- Monday - Thursday 8 PM – 6 AM sweeping of ward 2B and 3A.
- Residents are asked to sweep sidewalks in front of their properties.
- Sand should be placed in wind rows and not in piles so that the equipment can successfully remove it.

Road Work; Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards
Use SeeClickFix.com or call 978-829-1900 to report a pothole.
- Construction will continue on Lenox, Garfield, Richmond, Berkley Streets.
- Catch basin repair on Fairmount St and Clarendon St.
- Sewer manhole cover repairs on Wallace Ave in front of the Courthouse. Expect local road closures Tuesday – Thursday 7 AM – 3 PM.
- Gas main work by Unitil/NEUCO on Clarendon St from Franklin Rd to Pratt Rd; York Ave from Oak Hill to Hannigan Court; Beech St, Saint Andrew St, Chester St and First St at Railroad St. Expect road closures, detours and delays.
- Unitil will have tree crews on High St, Williams Rd, Sheldon St and mowing crews off Rollstone Rd and South St.

Hydrants:

- Inspection, maintenance and painting of hydrants City wide.
- Spring hydrant flushing will be delayed until further notice as to not cause discolored water for residents.
