The City of Fitchburg, Department of Public Works, advises residents of the following work that will be done – weather permitting – during the week of August 10, 2020.

Road Construction: Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 3 PM. Expect road closures, delays and detours.

- Beech Street reconstruction will continue all next week.
- Sidewalk construction on Clarendon Street from Columbus Street to Daniels Street will continue all next week.
- Gas main work by Unitil/NEUCO will continue all next week.
 - Franklin Road from Shea Street to Electric Avenue
 - Depot Street at Westminster St – Road Closed
 - York Avenue at Oak Hill Road
 - Clarendon Street from Pratt Road to Franklin Road

Street Sweeping: Monday - Friday 7 AM – 3 PM

- Spot sweeping City Wide.
- Residents are asked to sweep sidewalks in front of their properties.
- Sand should be placed in windrows and not in piles so that the equipment can successfully remove it.

Maintenance Work: Monday – Friday, 7 AM to 5 PM. Minor traffic impacts:

- Pothole repairs in all wards.
- Catch basin repair at 935 Water Street.
- Sewer cleaning & TV of various locations. Expect localized detours and lane shifts.
- Heavy sewer cleaning on Airport Rd near Benson St. Expect local detours and lane closures.

Hydrants:

- Hydrant flushing (hydrants with red tops) starting at Depot Street and going along Fairmont Street, Franklin Road and all side streets in between towards South Street.
- Hydrant flushing (hydrants with black tops) starting on Rindge Road towards the North Street area and the Mechanic Street area.
- Repair water gate boxes at various locations throughout the city.

The Water Meter Upgrade Project is currently on hold until further notice due to the COVID-19 outbreak. Plans are underway to restart the project in August.
