CONSTRUCTION DETOUR NOTICE

You are receiving this notice because a construction detour is expected to occur in your immediate vicinity as part of the ongoing sewer separation efforts.

J. A. Polito & Sons, Inc. is expected to be installing new sewer pipes and green infrastructure on Main Street starting Monday, April 1st, 2024. The work is expected to take approximately four weeks. During this time, through traffic on Main Street will be rerouted during the construction hours of 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday due to the location and depth of piping being installed. Main Street will remain accessible to local residents and businesses at the direction of Fitchburg Police. During non-construction hours and on weekends, vehicular access to Main Street will be permitted for all traffic.

This construction is considered critical infrastructure for your area, and will help prevent roadway stormwater flooding and/or possible sewer backups in your homes during wet weather events. **Please see the reverse side of this notice for an overview map of the detour route.**


Weston & Sampson will have a resident engineer on-site overseeing the construction of the sewer and drain separation project in your area. The City will also have Fitchburg Police on site for traffic management. Please be advised, the MassDOT River Street Bridge Project is also expected to begin shortly following the conclusion of this detour. At that time, the traffic pattern on River Street will be affected. Further information and notification for this work will be provided as construction approaches.

We understand that this disruption can be frustrating, but please know that the work being carried out is of the utmost importance for the betterment of our community. We kindly request your cooperation and understanding during this time. By working together, we can ensure that these improvements are completed safely and efficiently.
