




Fitchburg Announces Major Infrastructure and Construction Upgrades

The City of Fitchburg is rolling out a series of major infrastructure improvements aimed at upgrading water, sewer, and roadway systems throughout the downtown area. These projects, led by city engineers and multiple agencies, will enhance public utilities, modernize aging infrastructure, and improve overall quality of life for residents and businesses.

Key Projects in Progress

- Water System Upgrades: Improvements in Main Street, Moran Square, and Water Street to enhance water quality, increase fire flow, and replace aging infrastructure.
- Sewer & Drain Projects: Compliance with EPA, MassDEP, and DOJ regulations to separate combined sewer systems and reduce flooding risks.
- Gas Line Upgrades: Minor service connection upgrades led by Unitil in the downtown area.
- Bridge Replacements: MassDOT is overseeing the replacement of Water Street Bridge and River Street Bridge, along with new rail trail installations.
- Sidewalk & Pavement Repairs: Main Street sidewalk restoration and repaving efforts will enhance pedestrian safety and improve downtown accessibility.

- ✓ Strengthen water infrastructure and improve maintenance capabilities
- ✓ Reduce flooding risks and improve water quality
- ✓ Modernize sewer systems and meet environmental regulations
- ✓ Enhance roadways, sidewalks, and pedestrian access
