

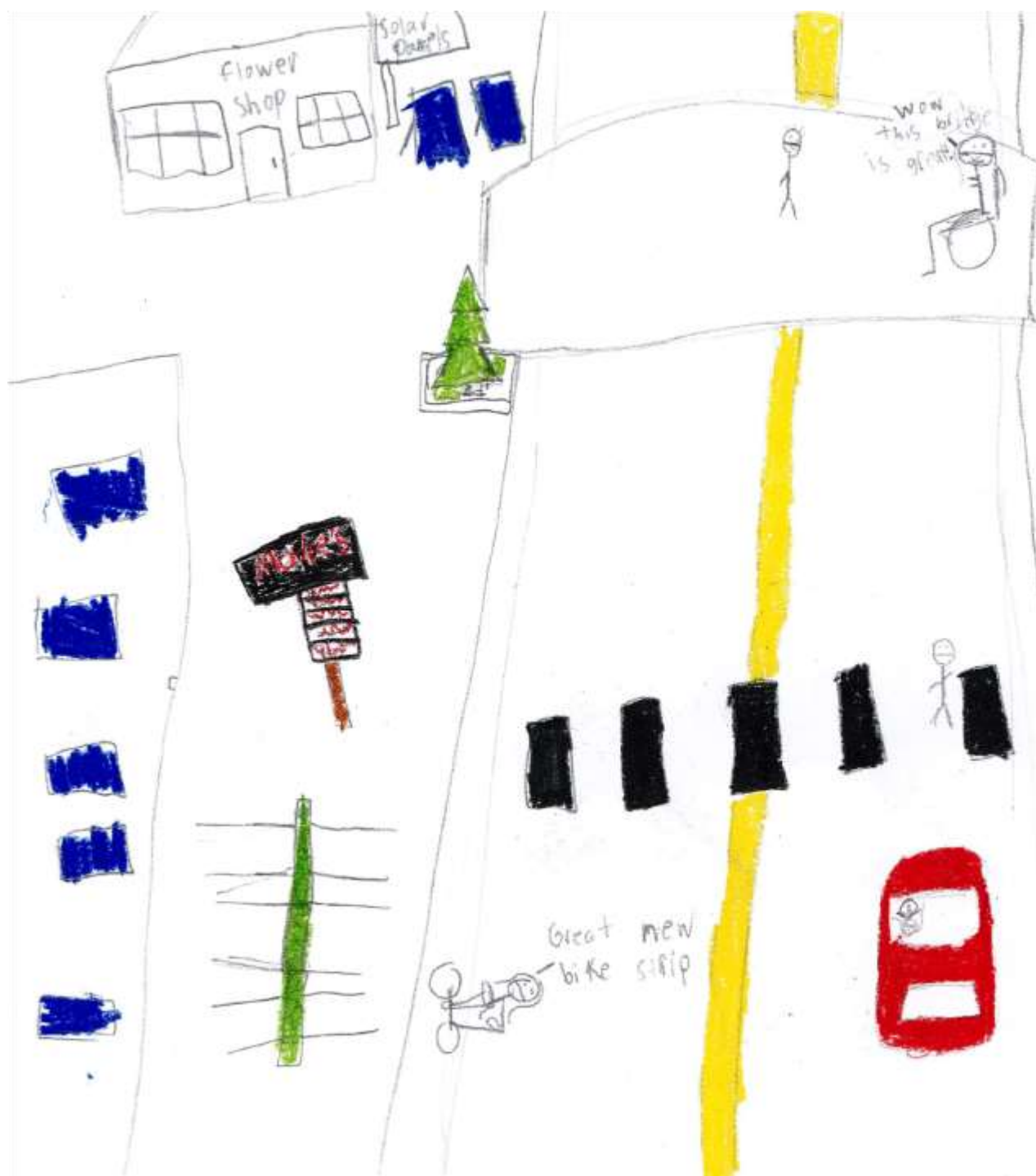


# Envision John Fitch Highway Artwork Challenge Submissions

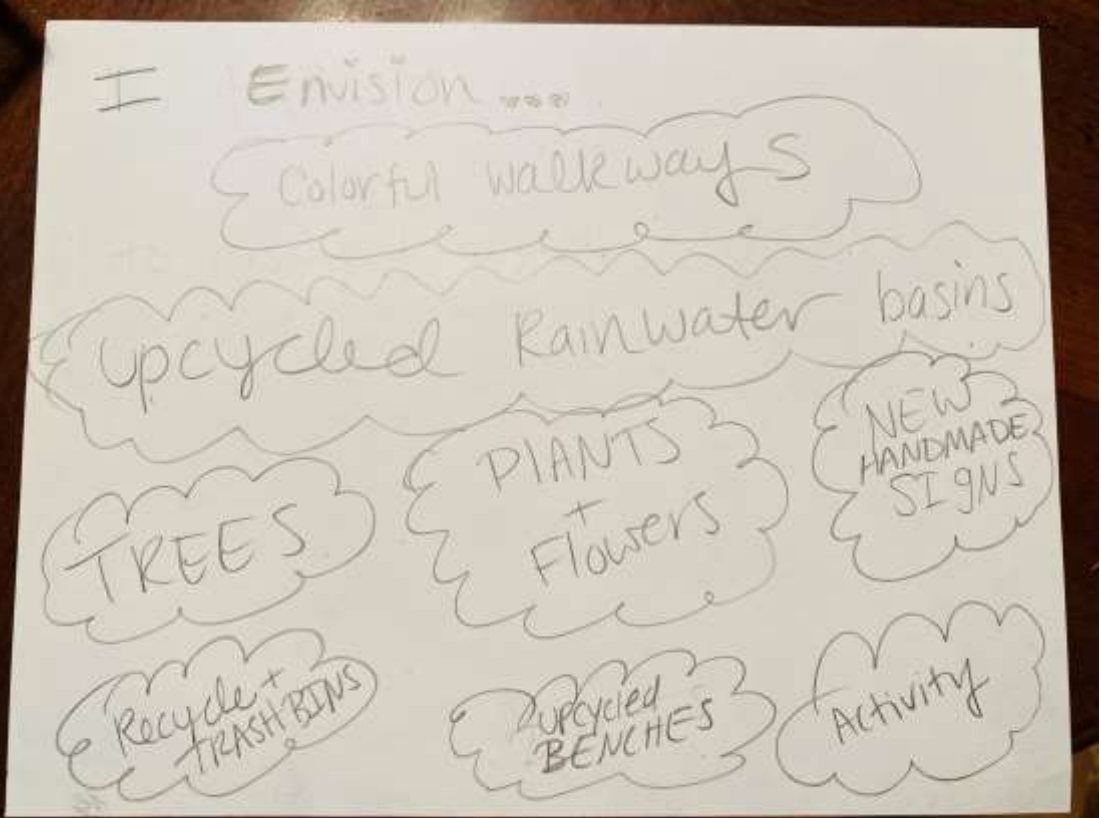
**Winner, Category: Youth – 13-18**
